



Amazon in Goodyear – Fast Facts

GYR1 Fast Facts

- Located in Goodyear, GYR1 is Amazon's fifth fulfillment center in the Phoenix metro area and the second fulfillment center in the City of Goodyear.
- The fulfillment center's footprint is 855,000 square feet. With four levels, the building spans more than 2.3 million square feet – about 40 football fields.
- More than 1,000 full-time associates will work alongside Amazon Robotics to pick, pack and ship smaller customer items such as books, toys and kitchenware.
- The site is the second Amazon Robotics fulfillment center in Arizona; the first opened in Tucson in September 2019.
- An Amazon Robotics fulfillment center has hundreds of robotic drive units, and thousands of shelving pods holding millions of products.
- The building was erected with more than 11,000 tons of structural steel – equal to the weight of 710 Tyrannosaurus Rexes.
- More than 566,000 tons of concrete was poured to construct the building's 220 exterior wall panels.
- Prologis is the developer of this facility and Layton Construction Company is the general contractor.

Amazon in Goodyear

- Amazon opened its first Goodyear fulfillment center in August 2008. More than 600 full-time employees pick, pack and ship larger items to customers such as oversized boxes of diapers, dog food and paper towels.
- Goodyear is also home to a delivery station and an office team that supports Amazon operations.
- Currently, more than 900 full-time employees support Amazon operations in Goodyear.
- In 2021, Amazon will open a Cross Dock facility to support its customer fulfillment network, creating an additional 1,000 full-time jobs in the City of Goodyear. This site will receive large orders of inventory and redistribute products to fulfillment centers across the company's operations network.
- Amazon has a long history of giving back to the communities where employees live and work. Since 2008, Amazon's funding and in-kind donations have supported the City of Goodyear's Home Plate for the Holidays and Great Estrella Day of Play, as well as Goodyear community organizations, including Estrella Youth Sports, Estrella Foothills High School and the Elíseo C. Félix School.

Goodyear Point of Pride: Bullard Tech Corridor

- Amazon's new fulfillment center is located in the City of Goodyear's Bullard Tech Corridor, a large land area full of opportunity close to I-10 which lends easy access to the 84,000 tech workers in the metro Phoenix market.
- Bullard Tech Corridor provides companies with a plethora of opportunities to build corporate campus facilities and offices, and offers a point-of-pride location in an upscale Technology Business Park.
- The Corridor boasts enhanced fiber capacity and connections which is strengthened by the location of multiple data centers. The robust electrical power, due to new substations in and around the Corridor, create enhanced reliability which technology companies can count on.
