



Amazon Growth in Metro Phoenix – Fast Facts – August 2020

Amazon will open 11 new sites across the Phoenix metro area by the end of 2020 to support customer fulfillment and delivery operations. The sites are expected to create more than 3,000 new full- and part-time jobs with a minimum \$15 per hour wage and comprehensive benefits starting on day one.

The new sites include seven delivery stations that power the last mile of Amazon's order fulfillment process. These sites will create hundreds of permanent, full-time and part-time jobs, in addition to offering entrepreneurs the opportunity to build their own small business delivering Amazon packages, and independent contractors the flexibility to be their own boss and create their own schedule delivering for Amazon Flex.

- **Chandler** – Arizona Avenue & Warner Road
- **Chandler** – McQueen Road & Pecos Road
- **Goodyear** – Litchfield Road & Yuma Road
- **Mesa** – Higley Road & McDowell Road
- **Phoenix** – 75th Avenue & Buckeye Road
- **Phoenix** – 40th Street & University Drive
- **Tempe** – Priest Drive & Broadway Road

Four additional facilities that support fulfillment operations will open by the end of 2020.

- **Avondale** – 103rd Avenue & Roosevelt Street
Merch by Amazon: a print on demand service that enables content creators to upload and sell custom content printed on apparel and electronics products to customers in Amazon's stores.
- **Goodyear** – Bullard Avenue & Yuma Road
Fulfillment Center: employees will work alongside Amazon robotics to pick, pack and ship small items to customers such as books, electronics and toys.
- **Phoenix** – 59th Avenue & Lower Buckeye Road
"AMXL" Fulfillment Center / Delivery Station: supports the fulfillment and delivery of large products, from televisions to couches, powered by drivers employed by Amazon's delivery service partners or national third party carriers.
- **Phoenix** – 83rd Avenue & Roosevelt Street
Cross Dock: supports customer fulfillment by receiving large orders of inventory and redistributing products to fulfillment centers across the company's operations network.

Amazon will launch two additional sites in 2021, creating 1,000+ full-time jobs in the West Valley:

- **Goodyear** – Indian School & Cotton Lane | *Cross Dock Facility*
- **Surprise** – Litchfield Road & Sweetwater Avenue | *Delivery Station*
